

Description

The Greenlee CR25 Cable Roller Guide is intended to install network data cables (Category 5, 5e, and 6). It is not intended for installation of electrical power cables.

The CR25 is constructed of heavy-duty 12 gauge cold rolled steel. It can be used while pulling up to 20 network data cables at once.

Safety

Operation


1. Clamp the CR25 onto a tray or joist and run cables through.



2. Close the bracket and install the quick release pin. Pull the cables through.

3. When finished, open the bracket and lay cables in the trough. Remove the CR25.




